In conjunction with ensuring compliance by ourselves and our customers with section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, as well as Section 13(p) to the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, relating to the use of Conflict Minerals, BRONCKHORST GmbH hereby states that we complete the following certification.

Defined Terms

"Covered Countries" means the Democratic Republic of Congo (the "DRC") and any country that shares an internationally recognized border with the DRC, which presently includes Angola, Burundi, Central African Republic, the Republic of Congo, Rwanda, South Sudan, Tanzania, Uganda, and Zambia.

"Conflict Minerals" means gold, tantalum, tin, and tungsten.

Certification

By countersigning below, BRONCKHORST GmbH ("Supplier") hereby certifies that all material it has and will supply (the "Materials") is "DRC conflict free" for the following reason:

- The Materials do not contain or utilize Conflict Minerals.
- Where Materials contain or utilize any Conflict Materials, such Conflict Minerals do not originate from any of the Covered Countries. Supplier has implemented procedures to identify and monitor the origin of materials that are produced with Conflict Materials
- The Materials that contain or utilize Conflict Minerals are from recycled or scrap sources.
